



How to 'See Practice' at Lambert Leonard & May

We are always keen to have students join us to 'See Practice'. However we often have a larger demand than we can cope with. We don't think we can provide a good experience for students if we have too many students come at one time. We therefore try to restrict numbers to just two regular students at one time. We can occasionally make room for a third student but restrict this place to somebody who has been before and has demonstrated exceptional enthusiasm and interest in dairy practice.

For students in the penultimate or final years at college we need to have evidence that you have developed a special interest in farm practice. For those students in the years below the final or penultimate years at college we will take anyone who can demonstrate enthusiasm and interest in farm work.

If you have not seen practice with us previously please submit a supporting letter from a suitable referee in addition to a letter of application containing the information detailed below:

- In general terms when you hope to come
- What you have heard about the Practice
- Why you want to see Practice at Lambert Leonard & May
- What previous farm-work or seeing Practice experience you have already
- What you hope to get out of your time with us

The referee can be anyone to whom you have already demonstrated enthusiasm and interest in farm work. This maybe a member of University staff or a farmer with whom you carried out farm work in your earlier years at

college. Please show the referee this document and ask that they write a note, which you can send onto us with your own letter. Their letter should contain the following information:

- How they know you and in what context
- How your enthusiasm and interest compares with others they have known
- Whether they think you may have a future in farm Practice

Once you have been to see practice with us we ask that you prepare a feedback form for us and provide a 'mug-shot' so we can remember you next time! We also pass a feedback form round the veterinary and support staff in order to decide if we would be keen to have you back next time. Occasionally we may agree that other students should take priority.

At any one time we like to offer support for one 'select student' that we hope will be part of the future of dairy vet Practice. This student will be able to take a third place during times when other students are with us and will be asked to get a little more involved with projects within the practice. We also hope that this student may be a possible candidate for the Lambert Leonard & May Internship in the future.

Summary

If you've seen Practice with us previously then just ask if you can come again.

If you haven't seen practice with us before then get a letter for support from a referee and then write or email with a letter of application.
